

P R E F A C E.

The coronation for which Handel composed the four following hymns, took place at Westminster Abbey on the 11th September 1727. The order of the festival, the arrangement of the choruses, &c., will be found fully described in my Life of Handel, II. 170—74. As there is no close connexion between these four separate anthems, and the order in which they succeeded one another at the original festivity cannot be determined with certainty, the editor must be guided by considerations of propriety in arranging them. Handel began with the composition of *Zadok the priest*, which should always stand first; and ended with that of the anthem to the Queen, *My heart is inditing*. In his manuscript they have now this order, 1. 3. 4. 2; but in Smith's transcript this, 4. 2. 3. 1. In Arnold's edition they stand thus, 4. 2. 1. 3; and in the edition of the former Handel Society thus, 2. 1. 3. 4. But our agreement agrees best with the requirements both of Handel's music and of the service.

The texts are frequently noted by Handel at the commencement of the pieces. In *Zadok the priest*: "1 Kings 1. 48" [it should be 39 and 40]. In *The King shall rejoice*: "¶ 45. V. 1. 10. 12. [Prayer Book Version.] ¶ [read Isaiah] 49. V. 23." In the anthem *Let thy hand be strengthened*, taken from the 89th Psalm, the text is not noted.

In the *Alleluiah* Handel often, in Italian fashion, blends the last syllable of one word with the first of the following: *Alleluji Alleluja*. The English editions, by not observing this, have given to the words a false rhythm at this place.

The pianoforte arrangement of the present edition is by Im. Faisst.

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
