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NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This arrangement of "Love for Sale" is a new twist on the timeless tune by Cole Porter. The low end of the band rules the day, carrying the melody most of the time. During these passages when baritone sax, bass trombone, piano, and bass have the melody (measures 9–40, 57–64) all other musical phrases, though complex, are background figures and should be subservient to the basses.

At measure 41, the sax section takes over the melody. This should be played with as full a sound as possible. Glisses leading into measures 73, 152, and 161 can be fairly dramatic, and as always, phrases with slurs on top should be performed as smoothly as possible.
