I have composed 'Echoes of Silent Voices' after Belgian violinist Leonard Schreiber told me the story of his grandparents, who survived the concentration camps during the second world war. Unfortunately they passed away before he was born. Inspired by this story, I started writing... :

I woke up in a dream in which every delusion became reality. Every shadow became a character. I captured every emotion in sound, I translated every image into music. I could smell every odour as if I was there, and I could hear the echoes of many silent voices. I woke up in a twilight which I knew wasn't real. Or was it?

How could I hear the echoes of voices that had long since lost their voice? Voices that would never speak again... unless it was through the voice of the violin.

I dedicate Echoes of Silent Voices' to the victims of the Holocaust, and to all people who are suffering from war, hatred and racisme.
