Vorwort

Bachs Kantate *Lobe den Herrn, meine Seele* (BWV 69a) ist ein Werk seines ersten Leipziger Amtsjahrs. Sie entstand zum 12. Sonntag nach Trinitatis und wurde am 15. August 1723 zum ersten Mal im Gottesdienst aufgeführt. Besetzung und Format des Werkes sind für einen gewöhnlichen Sonntag bemerkenswert aufwendig gehalten. Für den Eingangschor hat Bach möglicherweise auf eine besonders festlich gestaltete ältere Komposition zurückgegriffen und diese für den neuen Zweck parodiert. Nachweislich aus einem früheren Werk Bachs stammt der Schlusschoral, nämlich aus der 1714 in Weimar entstandenen Kantate *Weinen, Klagen, Sorgen, Zagen* (BWV 12).

Der festlich-repräsentative Charakter des Werkes veranlasste Bach viele Jahre später, wohl 1748, das Werk zu der Ratswahlkantate *Lobe den Herrn, meine Seele* (BWV 69) umzuarbeiten.¹

Beim Text des Eingangschors handelt es sich um Psalm 103, Vers 2. Den Beschluss der Kantate bildet die 6. Strophe des Liedes *Was Gott tut, das ist wohlgetan* von Samuel Rodigast (1649–1708) mit der Melodie von Severus Gastorius (1646–1682). Die Dichtung der Sätze 2–5 geht zurück auf den 1720/21 in Gotha gedruckten Textjahrgang *Gottgeheiligt Singen und Spielen des Friedensteinschen Zions* von Johann Oswald Knauer (geb. 1690). Der Text erscheint bei Bach jedoch in einer sehr freien und stark gekürzten Bearbeitung.

Foreword

Bach's cantata *Lobe den Herrn, meine Seele* (Praise the Lord, praise him and bless him) BWV 69a is a composition from his first year of service in Leipzig. It was composed for the 12th Trinity Sunday and first performed in a church service on 15 August 1723. Both the scoring and the dimensions of this work are unusually lavish for an ordinary Sunday. It is possible that Bach fell back on an older composition of a particularly festive character and parodied it for the opening chorus. The closing chorale is verifiably taken from an earlier work by Bach, namely the cantata *Weinen, Klagen, Sorgen, Zagen* BWV 12 which was composed in Weimar in 1714.

Many years later – probably in 1748 – the festive and illustrious character of the cantata motivated Bach to adapt it for the “Ratswahlkantate” (cantata for the council elections) *Lobe den Herrn, meine Seele* BWV 69.¹

The text for the opening chorus is Psalm 103, verse 2. The cantata closes with the 6th verse of the chorale *Was Gott tut, das ist wohlgetan* (Whate'er our God ordains is right) by Samuel Rodigast (1649–1708) on the melody by Severus Gastorius (1646–1682). The texts for movements 2–5 are based on the annual volume of texts *Gottgeheiligt Singen und Spielen des Friedensteinschen Zions* (Divinely consecrated singing and playing of the Friedenstein Zion) by Johann Oswald Knauer (b. 1690) which was printed in Gotha in 1720/21. The text which Bach used was, however, a very free and strongly abridged version.
